Drizzle and wind did not stop the 16 neighborhood volunteers from pulling on their rain boots and garden gloves for three hours on Saturday, April 13th at the Densmore Pathway! The sun shone not long after the start as it frequently seems to do. Several Red Flowering Currant and Serviceberry (also called Saskatoon), important for our pollinators, were planted, along with ferns and succulents - all native to the Puget Sound region.

Sit a spell at the green bench to read a few pages and catch up with neighbors, as many walk past and through the Pathway on N 188th Street between Ashworth and Densmore Avenues!
