## CUSTOMER RESPONSE TEAM

The Customer Response Team, or CRT, responds to and resolves inquiries, concerns, suggestions and complaints regarding City infrastructure and Code enforcement and serves as a referral source for City services. It probably has more relation to our everyday lives than any other city department.

They act as the City's (24 hours/7 days per week) first responders to emergency issues not requiring Police, Fire or Medical response.

The City of Shoreline Customer Response Team is available to receive requests 24 hours a day at (206) 801-2700. After 5:00pm, you can leave a voicemail, and on-call staff will be paged.

This month will be a joint meeting with the Meridian Park Neighborhood Association in the Council Chamber. Our speaker will be the **Supervisor of Code Enforcement and CRT, Bob Crozier**.

### DENSMORE PATHWAY AND N 195<sup>TH</sup> POLLINATOR GARDEN UPDATES

Fall is a superb time to add new plants to your landscape while also clearing out unwanted invasives! Fifteen Echo Lake Neighbors did just that October 6<sup>th</sup> at the Densmore Pathway, putting in almost 55 hours of volunteer time pruning, weeding and adding several new native perennials such as Aster and Nodding Onion near the green bench along Ashworth Ave. These native plants can survive drought conditions and only need minimal watering at first to get established.

Many are also important plants for our bees, butterflies and birds! Now is your chance to learn even more by visiting the new community Pollinator Garden to be planted November 3<sup>rd</sup> along N 195<sup>th</sup> and Meridian Ave thanks to a City of Shoreline Environmental Mini Grant received this summer by Hannah King-Jahnke, who is also a Washington Native Plant Steward. Over 200 plants are to be installed by enthusiastic volunteers and members of the Shoreline Garden Club.
