IF YOU SEE SOMETHING – SAY SOMETHING to the Police Non-emergency (206) 296-3311 – Emergency 9-1-1

When you see someone on your street doing something that seems wrong or out of place – call the police. No matter how big a police force we have or how many officers on the street, they can't be everywhere. Police depend on reports from citizens.

Call the police while you see something happening, not later. If they are available, they will come check it out and get back to you. They will contact the person politely and find out what they are doing. If police are not available, there will at least be a record so they can look for trends.

Solicitors must register with the City of Shoreline and get a license. If they don't have one with them, call the police.

Be prepared with a description of the person, the clothes they are wearing, and what direction they are traveling.

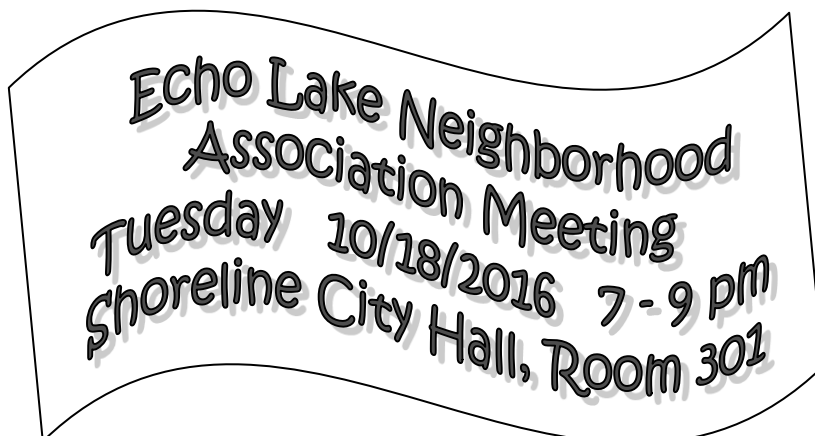
