

ECHO LAKE PARK CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Echo Lake Park is looking good, but the newly seeded lawn will not be ready to open for public use for several months. Although the grass appears to be lush and green, it is still tender to the footstep. We ask for your patience while the park is closed. City staff has worked with the project team to install drywells at Echo Lake Park to improve drainage in the open lawn area to eliminate the pooling water that was occurring due to construction activities that disrupted natural drainage. The disturbed grass in the area where the dry wells were installed will be restored after the soils have dried enough to level and reseed this area.
