SAFETY TIPS FOR PEDESTRIANS & BICYCLE RIDERS

Did you know that every 8 minutes a pedestrian is hit by a vehicle in the United States? What might be the statistics of cyclists hit by vehicles?

Whether walking or cycling, anytime you are out after dark, please wear **reflective gear** or **use lights** to alert drivers of your presence. A large variety of reflective gear is available: straps to attach to your jacket, arm and ankle bands, vests consisting of simple straps and jackets which all fit over your outerwear. Cyclists know there are many lighting options for the front and rear of bicycles. Prices begin as low as \$5 and items are available in stores right here in Shoreline. Wearing **light clothing** can provide more visibility also.

Keep your **pets** safe too. There are lights to attach to your dog's leash or collar, as well as reflective leashes and collars for both dogs and cats. As a driver, it's scary to be going even as little as 20 or 25 mph and suddenly see a pedestrian wearing dark clothing in your path. The same is true of an unseen dog whose leash allows it to be in the middle of the road.

Be smart, be safe, be SEEN!

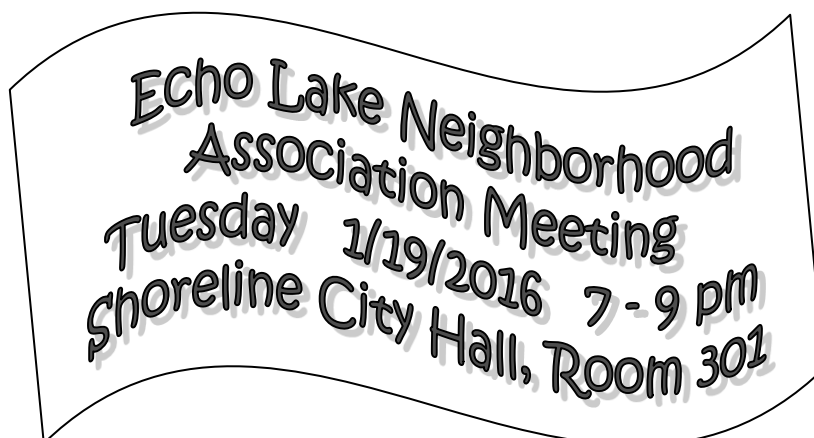
