PUGET SOUND MARINE MAMMALS AND BEACH ETIQUETTE RECAP

Rachel Mayer from Sno-King Marine Mammal Response (SKMMR) gave an informative presentation at the April meeting on Puget Sound marine mammals and how we can enjoy watching these mammals from a safe distance while promoting conservation at the same time. During the Summer and Fall, young seals learning to survive on their own also need quiet spaces onshore to rest.

Remember:

- Stay away at least 100 yds. from any marine mammal.
- Keep dogs and people away.
