We are just hoping for people who have an appreciation for the trees, shrubs, and flowers that adorn the Pathway. There are odd jobs too that don’t involve digging in the dirt.

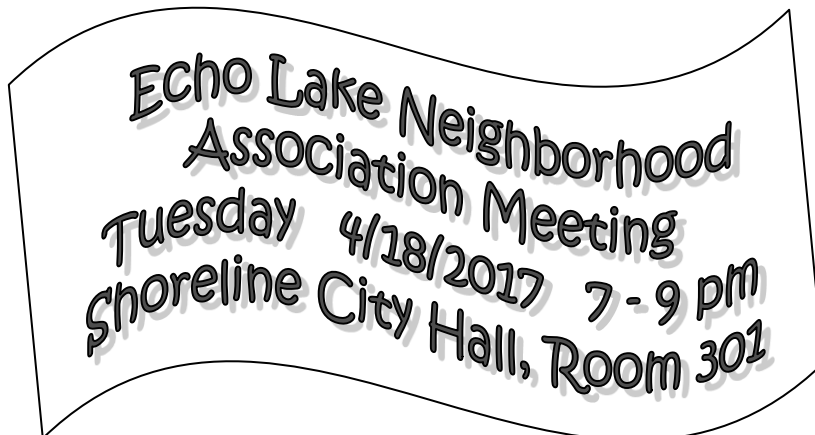
