WHY WATERSHEDS MATTER

Echo Lake is only one of many lakes and streams we have in our vicinity. Much of our rainfall and artesian springs culminate within Lake Forest Park traveling downstream to Lake Washington. McAleer, Thornton and Boeing Creek Watersheds are where most of us live in ELNA and can easily walk and commute during our errands and travels within a mile or two. Boeing Creek and smaller creeks to the west of ELNA enter Puget Sound directly, not even flowing into Lake Washington. Sustaining a healthy freshwater ecosystem plays an extremely important role in what changes we may have on Lake Washington water quality as it flows eventually into Puget Sound waters. Be aware of our wildlife and habitat while interacting with nature in your yards, streets and decisions on pesticide use. Removing greenery that helps filter out pollutants and stabilize the soils may have a wide range of impact on the health of Puget Sound. Learn more in upcoming ELNA newsletters and meetings as we understand just how lucky we are to live in this rich and irreplaceable Watershed humans and wildlife have called home for thousands of years and beyond.
