SHORELINE POLICE RADAR PROGRAM

Echo Lake is joining forces with the Meridian Park Neighborhood Association for our June meeting to hear a presentation from the Shoreline Police RADAR team.

The Shoreline Police Department's Response Awareness, De-escalation and Referral program, or RADAR, trains deputies to provide safe and effective responses when handling situations involving people with behavioral health problems.

RADAR is a complement to the crisis intervention training that helps reduce the use of force between police and individuals with behavioral issues and the repeated use of emergency services.

Officers are specially trained for the Behavioral Health unit and work with mental health professionals. They work with a "navigator" who is also a Behavioral Health Clinic Manager. Their goal is to de-escalate situations and help the individual get help, rather than jail.

The RADAR program has been operating since January, and we look forward to hearing about their experiences.

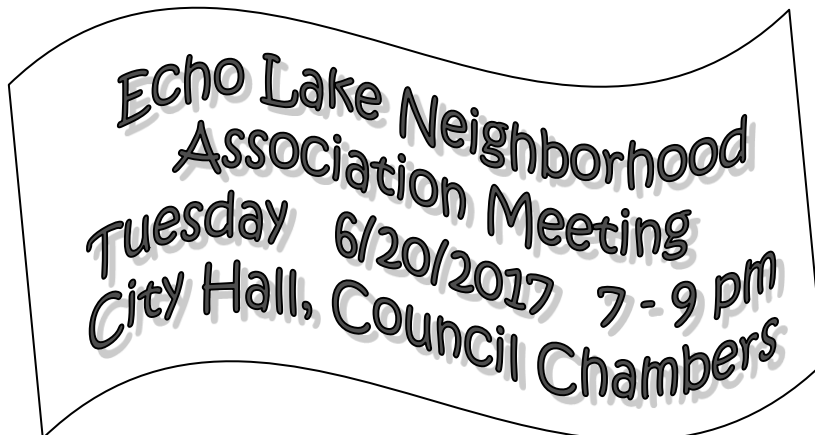
