One gap in Shoreline's complete streets network is the block between Stone Avenue (the Interurban Trail) and Ashworth Avenue N on N 195th Street. We will hear about the project to build a new sidewalk on the south side of N 195th to fill the gap. In addition, there will be an update on the sidewalk prioritization plan.

We will also hear about Shoreline's street light management and take a look at traffic.

RECYCLING TIPS

The May meeting was very informative when Elizabeth Szorad and Quinn Apuzzo came from Recology Cleanscapes. The main message was recycle items that are **CLEAN, DRY AND EMPTY**.

Blue Bin Recycling: "3D" plastic is OK (like bakery or takeout containers); "2D" (flat) plastic is not. Rinse out drink bottles; plastic caps and labels may be left on plastic bottles. No loose plastic lids less than 3". Items are recycled based on the type of plastic, not the "PET" number on the underside. Labels may be left on metal cans. Sharp can lids are garbage. Very clean aluminum foil can be rolled into a softball-sized ball.

Green Bin Food Scraps & Yard Debris: No metal or plastic! Yes to food waste, paper with food on it, and yardwaste from the garden.
