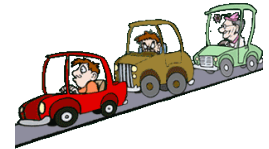

With the construction of the 185th Street light rail station, rezoning around the station and planned development of Point Wells, traffic will be changing in Shoreline and in the Echo Lake neighborhood in particular.

City Traffic Engineer Kendra Dedinsky and Transportation Planning Manager Nytasha Sowers will join us to talk about how the city responds to traffic issues and give us a look at the future of Shoreline traffic.

The work party crew at the Densmore Pathway Weeding event on October 18<sup>th</sup> was small, but mighty. Eleven volunteers donated 40 workhours of time and accomplished a great deal of weeding, pruning, mowing, and removing blackberry vines. In spite of a rainy forecast, it was a perfect day with the sun even breaking out and about a handful of rain drops falling.

Our Echo Lake Neighborhood Association is responsible for the upkeep on the Pathway, as a part of the mini-grant received from the City of Shoreline to make the Pathway become a reality – that and a number of volunteers led by landscape artist and neighbor Roy Mangel. All of that initial effort resulted in a third place national award from Neighborhoods USA (plaque pictured).
