WILL SOUND TRANSIT OR SHORELINE TAKE YOUR HOME?

Some homeowners recently received letters from Sound Transit which contained confusing language. At the joint Echo Lake/Meridian Park Neighborhood meeting held Tuesday, September 19th, Roger Iwata stated that Sound Transit has already notified homeowners in writing and purchased properties for the 185th Station and guideways. It is still possible that, as the project design is refined, additional property could be needed. One possible change to the project involves the parking garage, which is currently shown on the west side of I-5. Recent discussions with Shoreline may result in it moving to the east side of I-5 and if so, it is possible more properties would be needed. In that case, Sound Transit would contact those owners.

The recent letters were to contact property owners whose property may be needed for temporary access to the project site during the construction phases. The amount of land needed and the impacts will vary.

If your property is in the 185th rezone area, you most probably have been hearing from private developers and land speculators seeking to purchase contiguous parcels in order to build multi-story buildings. You and your immediate neighbors are free to work together or individually to sell to the same developer, but you do not have to sell. You can stay where you are. The City of Shoreline is not using "eminent domain" to force people to sell but some speculators have been sending misleading flyers designed to scare you into selling to them.
